ISSUES:

Overlaps between panels requirements

Overlaps between our requirements and other requirements derived from other FI working groups (such as MANA)

FISO provides the service layer for MANA - services perspective on cross-layer management

The overlaps between MANA and FISO are significant and unclear -

- FISO aims to provide a set of requirements to be endorsed by research projects
- MANA aims to provide a white paper

MANA requirements are quite all-inclusive.

Review reports - derive requirements - request elaboration from Panel chairs where necessary (John Domingue & Graham Hench)

Speak with Alex Galis in order to define the relationship between MANA and FISO (John Domingue)

2) Status of the 2015 scenarios - original email below:

*We are now beginning in earnest to plan for FIA Prague. In addition to the FISO requirements above Joao da Silva would like each WG to propose a set of scenarios (3-4) of what the 2015-and-beyond Internet would look like based upon *what if questions* and incorporating conflicting trends. Associated with each scenario should be a list of concrete research topics which would address the unknowns in each scenario. Highlighting specific needs here related to testing and*

experimentation is encouraged. The scenarios would form input to a paper that would serve as the basis for a broad consultation with research and industrial communities and government authorities. The paper would be presented and discussed in Prague.

The deadline for the above is very short - January 30th.

ISSUES:

S-Cube - awaiting input

Service Web 3.0 - awaiting input

NEXOF-RA - list of ~40 scenarios in a public deliverable - Anne-Marie Sassen and John Domingue have selected a couple from the list which involve BT (and the BT 21c initiative) - these scenarios will be posted on the Services wiki

Propose hypothetical questions ("what if") wrt. Future Services --> propose potential solutions/research strategy

Perhaps adopt the socio-economic WG methodology (address "what-if")?

2015 - implies plausible and achievable, rather than overly optimistic

ACTION ITEM:

Publish NEXOF-RA deliverable which identifies potential scenarios on wiki (Graham Hench)

Preliminary "what ifs" = associated research challenges = associated testbed (Mike Boniface)

Advisory guidance in preparation of scenarios for Feb 6th (Anne-Marie Sassen)
