Main Action Items

1. Action points from last telecon

- a) Mike Boniface – circulate existing ‘vision’ paper → **done**
- b) All – circulate existing or newly generated vision papers which are relevant to the email list → **done**
- c) John Domingue – liaise with Eurescom to create an area for the WG to store relevant documents → **done**
- d) John Domingue – liaise with Eurescom to create Wikis as required by the WG topic areas → **done**
- e) Mike Papazoglou and Stefano de Panfilis – circulate a short description for the Architectures and Infrastructures topic. Deadline Friday June 6th → **done**
- f) Nick Wainwright, Mike Papazoglou and Stefano de Panfilis – send Alex Galis 2-3 slides outlining the Trust, and Architectures and Infrastructures topics respectively for his presentation on our WG activities during the Mobile Summit June 10-12
Mike Boniface – define a life-cycle topic with an intention to go to the socioeconomic sub-group within the Networks WG. → **done**

2. Brief report on any relevant past events including:

John Domingue gave a recap of this event (roughly 50 representatives from Japan attending and around 50 presentations). Interested/relevant sessions mentioned: wireless network – clean state approach; ubiquities tag, security session. John talked about work with chips and especially their miniaturization. Experimental internet collaboration. Interesting issues

concern SAP presentation. SAP carries out SOCRATES project – where services represent objects and are further mapped to processes. SAP is interested in the Future of the Internet initiative.

Short discussion on the Planetlab and Tegel testbeds followed (experimental facilities of Future Internet). It is open to anybody who is willing to do experiments. Tegel wants to represent nodes as services having SOA as a facilitating technology.

b) NEM Summit - Alex Galis

Alex gave a short summary of the FIA Cluster Meeting in Stockholm where projects from the area of mobility and networks were present. In the FIA Cluster meeting room, there were about 70-80 people. Due to a very tight agenda, there was not enough time for discussion, but presentations were really good. The problem we face is proliferation of the group that creates fragmentation of work. Consolidation of views is needed.

John: Consolidation should be assured by future Internet Portal hosted by Eurescom. Let's try to produce a map presenting all of the groups.

Nick: This consolidation, definition of focus should happen before the meeting in Madrid.

3. Report on each of our 4 topics (topic leaders)

Alex: Management and Governance

- proposal for this topic to be one of the topics in Madrid (as a subsession)
- management is not something completely new → this is a continuation of this topic, but with a couple of changes e.g. bandwidth constraints are disappearing; another topic is searching for large number of services which are deployed on the network.

Nick: Trust

- talks with HP to have working group about new activities – a session planned for September – currently exchange of materials takes place
- September will be a crucial month for the group and its work.
- There are different working groups in place → a wish was expressed to converge them finally into one group
- Granularity with Internet growth → granularity issue will emerge
- Nick also reported about the upcoming panel at Future Internet symposium in Madrid

Short overview of the idea of the September Concentration meeting.

Stefano: Architectures and Infrastructures

- WG produced manifesto where future work is defined
- Stefano has reported lack of contributions from other groups
- How to proceed with the work? How to organize the work between working groups? How to synchronize work?
- Collect ideas how to build bottom up ideas about what should be future internet and its infrastructure

Stefano to contact Dimitri Papadimitriou from the Networks WG. There is a need to coordinate the work between groups. John talked with Henrik Abramowicz on these topics (no response yet). Coordination of this initiative: Stefano, John and Anne-Marie Sassen.

Manifest of the WG should provide some ideas for definition of future projects.

4. Service Web 3.0 work including vision document and Future Internet Movie

John shortly elaborates on the idea. Everyone to send comments on the story board sent out by John. The idea is to create **meta vision document** out of other vision documents → should be ready for Madrid meeting. John also reported about movie, which is in preparation (as part of Service Web 3.0 project). There is a generic part of the movie and a specific part about semantic technologies.

5. Brief discussion on working methods including the WG Wiki (services.future-internet.eu)

Contributions to the Wiki are strongly encouraged. It was very useful to create topic proposals for the Madrid meeting. As for the access rights: everyone can read the content, but only registered people can edit it.

6. Upcoming events including: EU concertation meeting (Preliminary Agenda attached)

Format of the meeting is influenced by the working group. Three topics addressed are panel sessions being plenary sessions. There is also an organizational session planned, aiming at provision of important information on how the group collaborates (for potentially interested people). Comments can be sent to Anne-Marie
